## Alumnus providing a voice for refugees



We are proud to announce that alumnus **Abdul Hekmat** joined the Australian representative team at the UNHCR consultations in Geneva. Abdul contributed to June forums on Hazara refugees whose lives have been devastated by a spate of terrorist attacks in Pakistan. He and the team also gave voice to the struggles of Afghan refugees and asylum seekers in Iran, Greece and Christmas Island.

During the consultation process, they set in motion important agendas for executives to act upon in September, and they networked with key people from the UNHCR. Abdul said it was an experience of "incredible and committed organisations coming

together from around the world. I have networked with organisations from many countries that deal with Afghan refugees, Iran, Pakistan, Italy and a few others. Hopeful signs to continue to work in the future. I am very fortunate to be part of a very committed team from Australia, Graham Thom (Amnesty International), Paul Power (Refugee Council of Australia), David Manne (Immigration and legal Centre in Melbourne) and staff of Refugee Research Centre UNSW. We are the most effective and organised team at UNHCR and our work is really a standout here.'
